Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal. Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear chemical resistant protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with Fire water fog, foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed drums with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away. **FIRST AID** If Swallowed: Do NOT induce vomiting.
