### EMERGENCY PROCEDURES 24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 243 622

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or leak</b>	Wear Chemical resistant protective (PPE) clothing including: goggles, respiratory protection (organic vapour minimum specification), full length coveralls, gloves, boots/footwear. Prevent spillage from entering drains or water courses. Absorb spillage with clay, sand, vermiculite or other suitable absorbent material. If spill is too large or if absorbent material is not available, try to create a dike to stop material spreading or going into drains or waterways. Sweep up and shovel or collect recovery product into labelled containers for recycling or salvage, and dispose of promptly. After spills, wash area with a detergent based solution preventing runoff from entering drains. If a significant quantity of material enters drains, immediately advise regional council and emergency services. Ensure appropriate legality of disposal of contaminated materials by consulting local authority regulations prior to disposal
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> Wear chemical resistant protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with water fog, foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. During a fire, toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed drums with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

### FIRST AID

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not scrub the skin.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop.

### STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

**Storage:** Store in original container in a secure, cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, seeds, fertilisers, and ensure inaccessibility to children and/or animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.

**Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds:** When stored with substances of the same hazard classification the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Emergency Management Regulations.
