IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or leak	DO NOT touch or walk through spilled material. Wear facemask or goggles, chemical resistant overalls (buttoned to neck and wrist), gloves and boots. Prevent entry into waterways and drains. Sweep up spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authorities regarding disposal.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Fumes and combustion products produced in a fire may be toxic and/or irritating. Small fire: Use dry chemical, CO ₂ , water spray or foam. Large fire: Use foam, alcohol foam or water fog. If safe to do so, move undamaged containers from fire area. Deny unnecessary entry. Do not allow material or run-off to enter waterways.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Call the National Poisons Centre (0800 POISON/ 0800 744 766) or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the Poison Centre or doctor. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If in Eyes:	Immediately flush eyes with water; remove contact lenses, if present, after the 5 minutes, then continue flushing eyes for at least 15 minutes. Obtain medical attention without delay, preferably from an ophthalmologist
If on Skin:	Remove material from skin immediately by washing with soap and plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes while washing. Seek medical attention if irritation persists. Wash clothing before reuse. Discard items, which cannot be decontaminated, including leather articles such as shoes, belts, and watchbands.
If Inhaled:	Move person to fresh air; if effects occur, consult a physician.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store in tightly closed original container in a cool, dry well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight when not in use. Do not store with animal or human foods, feedstuffs, remedies, fertilisers seeds fungicides or insecticides. See product label for further handling/storage precautions relative to the end use of this product.
