Tanker/Vehicle	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks.					
Accident	Call the emergency services: Dial 111					
Spill or leak	Keep all bystanders away. Wear chemical resistant protective clothing, goggles, half face-piece respirator with combined dust and vapour cartridge and chemical resistant gloves. Absorb spilled product in non-organic materials and place in a sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Seek advice from local authority regarding disposal.					
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear chemical resistant protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish with water fog, foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed dr with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

If Swallowed:	Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.					
If in Eyes:	Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
